

Consultant: Investor Engagement

UNI Global Union is seeking a consultant to support our work to advance institutional investor action on workers' rights. The consultant will work with UNI's Investor Engagement Advisor, supporting UNI's sectoral teams on company campaigns and labour rights issues in the skills and services sectors UNI represents. Sectors in focus likely will include Care, ICTS and Commerce.

Working with our affiliated unions, UNI represents workers in over 150 countries in industries such as Cleaning & Security, Care, Commerce, Finance, Telecommunications and IT. Key tasks

The consultant will:

- Develop investor-facing materials, including research reports, letters and public communications.
- Support in dialogue with a range of investor, trade union, NGO and policy audiences.
- Draft submissions for relevant consultations or feedback opportunities.
- Develop and conduct trainings for institutional investors on labour rights issues.
- Support strategy development and implementation of strategic campaigns.
- Expand UNI's relationships with the responsible investment and business and human rights networks.
- Participate in regular meetings of key networks.

Experience & Competencies

The ideal candidate will have:

- Strong skills in written and verbal communication with a range of audiences.
- Ability to quickly understand new subject matter and synthesize large amounts of information.
- Experience of undertaking desk-based corporate research and producing reports
- Knowledge of trade unions, fundamental labour rights and business and human rights due diligence.
- Knowledge of responsible investment and experience engaging with investors is desirable.
- Experience of building relationships and motivating a wide range of stakeholders.
- Effective time management skills, including prioritising and managing multiple tasks and meeting deadlines.

- Fluency in spoken and written English is essential, knowledge of other languages is desirable. French or German language skills would be a particular advantage.
- A strong personal commitment to the goals of the trade union movement and of UNI Global Union.

Terms of contract

This will be a consultancy contract from the 1 September 2024 to the 1 November 2025. The consultant shall be contracted for providing 10 - 15 days of work per month.
